JOB SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of the Director of Health and Wellness Director, the Outreach Worker provides outreach counseling and support services to C/TFN citizens in a difficult or trying situations involving health issues, child and family matters, justice issues, addictions and other social issues. The Outreach Worker will use the Values and Virtues of Life, the Medicine Wheel as the basis of re-engaging and providing opportunities for life skills, education and employment for C/TFN citizens. The person in the position must be willing to change with the ongoing evolution of C/TFN circle of governance.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Grade twelve with/or a combination of postsecondary coursework in Social Programs, Counseling, Mental Health, Psychology, Social Sciences, Sociology
- Knowledge of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder and other mental disorders and ability to help educate others on the topic;
- Experience in assessing and dealing with high risk situations;
- Knowledge of C/TFN Family Act, book 1 & 2;
- Knowledge or willingness to implement the Theory of Change concept into the program; good knowledge of the communities of Carcross, Tagish, Squanga and Whitehorse;

CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT

- C/TFN Health and Wellness Department requests that all Health and Wellness
 - employees are role models for a substance abuse free lifestyle or are working on their individual wellness plan;
 - To submit to a Criminal Record Check;
 - Willingness to work flexible hours
 - May occasionally be required to transport clients on a as needed basis;
 - To function in a potentially stressful environment;
